## Bible Study for January and February 2021 Transforming our hearts in the Beatitudes

In the Beatitudes our Lord Jesus outlines the way to spiritual profit. He describes the heart conditions that receive the full blessings of God. Our study in January and February of 2021 will focus on the transformation of the heart in and through the Beatitudes. We will be using the entire Sermon on the Mount (Matthew, chapters 5 to 7) asour text while drawing on the Church Fathers as well as more contemporary Orthodox sources for assistance. Christ came to save us and lead us into the Kingdom of Heaven. He did His part. The second part requires are active cooperation. We have to walk through the door. The hope is that we will:

- 1. Memorize & understand the Beatitudes
- 2. Practice and grow in their application
- 3. Share insights
- 4. Share challenges
