That birth took place on the Lord's Day in the upper room where the apostles gathered with Mary and the disciples. Here the Holy Spirit was poured out upon them from the Father through Christ. Up to this point the apostles were afraid, but at that gathering God gave them the Spirit and changed them. Through the Spirit they had power to preach the truth that overcame the world. We are given power through that same Spirit and we can overcome our fears and spiritual laziness. But this means coming and seeing and hearing and softening our hearts. It means being with God through the abiding presence of that Spirit of God in our midst each time the Spirit assembles us. Here we are not passive spectators but active receivers of the Spirit's power just as on that first Pentecost.</p> </div> | | | |
