4. After Paschal Divine Liturgy on Bright Monday at 9:30 am - Baskets to be brought to the church proper and kept on the pews.
5. After Paschal Divine Liturgy on Bright Tuesday at 9:30 am - Baskets to be brought to the church proper and kept on the pews.
