IMPORTANT NEWS – ON SUNDAY JUNE 23rd SPECIAL PARISH MEETING WAS HELD, WITH QUORUM ESTABLISHED AND PRESENT, TO REVIEW, DISCUSS AND VOTE ON OUR CAPITAL PROJECT OF REPAINTING ALL OF OUR CHURCH DOMES AND BASES. HAVING REVIEWED AND DISCUSSED 3 PROPOSALS AND UPON UNANIMOUS RECOMMENDATION OF OUR PARISH COUNCIL, JEFF'S PAINTING WASHING AND REMODELING COMPANY OF BRACKNEY PA, WAS SELECTED AS PREFERABLE OPTION FOR THIS CAPITAL PROJECT. JUST AS A POINT OF INFORMATION, THIS COMPANY (BONDED AND FULLY INSURED) IS THE SAME COMPANY THAT WASHED, RE-PLASTERED AND REPAINTED THE ENTIRE INTERIOR OF OUR CHURCH, AS WELL AS WELL AS OUR CHURCH HALL, 4 YEARS AGO. IN KEEPING WITH OUR BYLAWS, THE MOTION WAS MADE TO ENGAGE JEFF'S PAINTING, WASHING AND REMODELING COMPANY OF BRACKNEY PA FOR THE PROPOSED WORK. MOTION WAS SECONDED, DISCUSSED AND A VOTE WAS TAKEN. VOTE WAS – ALL IN FAVOR, NONE OPPOSED AND NO OBSTANTIONS. UPON UNANIMOUS APPROVAL BY THE SPECIAL PARISH MEETING ON JUNE 23rd, CONTRACT WAS SIGNED WITH THE COMPANY ON WEDNESDAY JUNE 26th. THE WORK IS SCHEDULED TO BEGIN ON AUGUST 12th (WEATHER PERMITTING) AND WILL BE COMPLETED IN 7-12 DAYS. The transfiguration of Christ is one of the central events recorded in the gospels. Immediately after the Lord was recognized by his apostles as “the Christ [Messiah], the Son of the Living God,” he told them that “he must go up to Jerusalem and suffer many things ... and be killed and on the third day be raised” (Mt 16). The announcement of Christ's approaching passion and death was met with indignation by the disciples. And then, after rebuking them, the Lord took Peter, James, and John “up to a high mountain”—by tradition Mount Tabor—and was “transfigured before them.”
